



Alberta Snowboarding Association Athlete Code of Conduct

Every athlete who is a member of the Alberta Snowboarding Association must adhere to the following Code of Conduct while at or participating in ASA sanctioned, sponsored events, or training sessions:

- 1) Refrain from becoming, giving the appearance, or being intoxicated.
- 2) Refrain from threatening and/or abusive language and behavior.
- 3) Speak to competition officials in a constructive manner and make any appeals through the proper channels only.
- 4) Recognize the need for safety and refrain from any reckless activity.
- 5) Respect other persons, public and private property, and the rules, regulations, or norms of conduct of public occasions.
- 6) Refrain from possessing or using illegal substances.

Every athlete shall recognize that he/she is viewed as being a representative of Alberta and the Alberta Snowboarding Association, even when not acting in any official capacity, and shall govern themselves accordingly at all times.

Every athlete acknowledges that any breach in the Alberta Snowboarding Association Athlete Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from the ASA.
